Each week, teaching and support staff at Southborough nominate a member of the Sixth Form that, in their opinion, have 'gone the extra mile' and thus deserve the title of 'Sixth Form Hero of The Week'. It may be in recognition for the student working extra hard, being a brilliant role model, or achieving well in an exam. Students may also be nominated for doing something worthwhile outside of school, for example taking part in a special fund-raising event for charity. Whatever the reason, the award is to publically recognise the personal achievement of a particular individual Sixth Former and, as a consequence, a new 'Hero' is celebrated within the Sixth Form weekly morning assembly.

The 'Hero of The Week' is announced in assembly in front of the entire Sixth Form every Wednesday morning and a small gift is presented to him/her.
