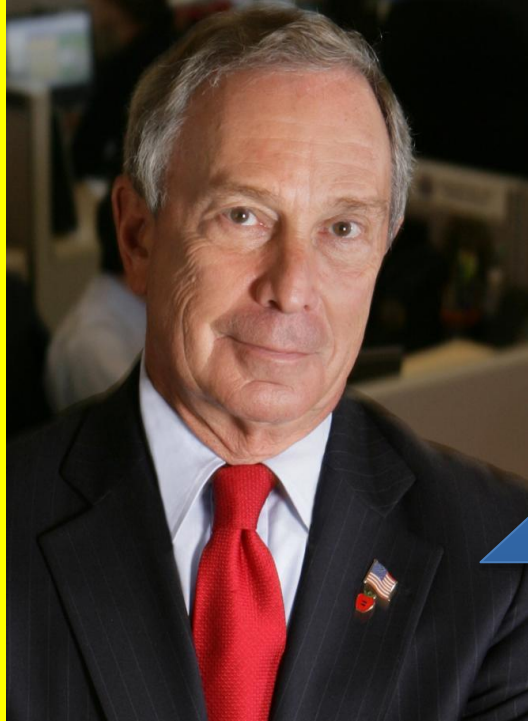
- Mutual Respect is a key British value
