Monday 8th – Friday 12th October 2018

Subject: Maths

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 30 minutes

List of topics to revise: full page of content list published electronically on Google Drive shared with students covering a range of topics such as fractions, decimals, percentages, equations, scatter graphs, angles, Pythagoras, Venn diagrams and quadratics.

Subject: Statistics

Content and length of exam: 2 hour exam (sets 1&2) and 1 hour 30 minutes exam (mixed sets if sitting stats)

List of topics to revise: full page of content list published electronically on Google Drive shared with students covering a range of topics such as hypotheses, types of data, sampling methods, tables, charts and diagrams, range, and probability.

Subject: English language

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 45 Paper 2. Q1-4 (reading) 1hour. Q5 (writing) 45mins

List of topics to revise: Q1-4 - Pick up nonfiction texts, supplements in newspapers, online articles etc and then practice answering the questions. They will always follow the same format! There are also plenty of past papers that are available from teachers. Online helpful resources are Mr Bruff's YouTube channel and BBC Bitesize.

Q5 - Read non-fiction articles/essay as good examples – editor opinion pieces in broadsheets are perfect examples. Make sure you focus on including a variety of sentence structure, punctuation and vocabulary. Try to include specific language techniques. Maybe even make a 'checklist' of things to include. Online helpful resources are Mr Bruff's YouTube channel and BBC Bitesize.

Subject: English literature

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 45 Paper 1

List of topics to revise: Know your texts –Macbeth and Jekyll & Hyde. Practice PQE response/MESSI. Learn key quotes for the texts (as all are closed book exams) Maybe even make a 'checklist' of things to include. Online helpful resources are Mr Bruff's YouTube channel and BBC Bitesize.

Subject: Science

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 30 minutes

List of topics to revise: comb B (all year 10 bio units), comb p (all year 10 p units), comb c (all year 10 c units & reactivity of metals), triple b (all year 10 b units, reproduction & inheritance, variation & evolution), triple c (all year 10 c units, equilibria & fertilisers, ions), triple p (all year 10 p units, waves and forces)

Subject: Drama

Content and length of exam: 1 hour

List of topics to revise:

Component 1, section c- re-read and revise 'The play that goes wrong'. REMEMBER the more detail in your answers, the better.

Component 1, section a- revise technical theatre, role and responsibilities. Refer to the thick booklet from class.

Go over the mocks we have already done on these two sections and practice re-writing your answers. Practice your answers based on your feedback. Revise all drama skills and refer to the purple handout in your books.

Subject: Media studies

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 30 minutes 1-12 mark questions Exploring Media Industries and audiences

List of topics to revise: Component One Section B: Video games, introduction & overview of Pokémon Go. Industry & Pokémon Go. Audience & Pokémon Go.

Component Two Section B: music video & online media overview of topic & music industry. Analysis of contemporary video 1 (Taylor Swift or Katy Perry) – ML & rep (gender). Contexts of contemporary music videos, audience response.

Subject: Spanish

Content and length of exam: Holidays. Two exams = 1 hour 30 minutes (1 x reading = 30 minutes & 1 x writing = 1 hour). Listening will take place prior during normal lessons.

List of topics to revise: holiday destinations & preferences, what you usually/can do on holiday, holidays in the past/disastrous holidays, telling a story using sequencing words, using prepositions for countries and modes of transport, revision of estar + past participle, revision of the imperfect and preterite tenses, describing a region in Spanish, and talking about the weather.

Subject: French

Content and length of exam: Holidays. Two exams = 1 hour 30 minutes (1 x reading = 30 minutes & 1 x writing = 1 hour). Listening will take place prior during normal lessons.

List of topics to revise: holiday destinations & preferences, what you usually/can do on holiday, holidays in the past/disastrous holidays, telling a story using sequencing words, using prepositions for countries and modes of transport, revision of the perfect tense of avoir, revision of the imperfect tense of avoir, être and faire, describing a region in France, and talking about the weather.

Subject: History

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 15 minutes SPR 1 Full paper 2

List of topics to revise: Period study: Superpower relations and the Cold War, 1941–91. Revise Cold War up to the Hungarian Revolution from the textbook.

Subject: Business Studies

Content and length of exam: Enterprise and Entrepreneurship & making business effective. 1 hour.

Subject: Geography

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 15 minutes

List of topics to revise: Coasts.

- Impact of marine processes on the coast: Erosion (Hydraulic Action, Abrasion, Solution, Attrition)
- Impact of land processes on the coast: Weathering (Chemical, Biological, Mechanical) Mass Movement (Rock Falls, Sliding, Slumping) Transportation & Deposition
- Influence of waves and geology on the coastal landscape (including types of waves and geological structures)
- How different coastal landforms are formed (Cliffs and wave-cut platforms, caves, arches and stacks)
- Landforms formed through coastal deposition (Longshore drift, beaches, spits, bars, tombolos)
- Investigate coastal landscapes using OS maps
- The causes and effects of coastal erosion and recession

Subject: Computer Science

Content and length of exam: 2 papers – 50 minutes each

List of topics to revise: full 7 page revision list published electronically on Google Drive shared with students covering a range of topics such as algorithms, programming, data structures, sub routines, units of information, cyber security, malicious code, and Boolean logic.

Subject: Physical Education

Content and length of exam: Paper 2 1 hour 30 minutes

List of topics to revise: 1.1.1 Physical, emotional and social health, fitness and wellbeing, 1.1.2 consequences of a sedentary diet, 1.1.3 energy use, diet, nutrition and hydration

Subject: Food Preparation & Nutrition

Content and length of exam: 'Food Nutrition and health' with elements of 'Food Preparation skills' related to that topic. 1x 50 minute exam.

List of topics to revise: Macronutrients (Protein, fats, carbohydrates), Micronutrients (water soluble and fat soluble vitamins, minerals, water), Making informed choices for a varied and balanced diet (Eat Well Guide), Energy Needs, Nutritional analysis, Diet, Nutrition and Health.

Subject: Design & Technology

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 30 minutes

List of topics to revise: new & emerging technologies – industry, enterprise, sustainability, people, culture, society. Also – systems approach to designing – inputs, process and outputs

Subject: Religious studies

Content and length of exam: 1 hour 30 mins based on content from year 10

List of topics to revise: Revise:

Chapter 1- of both RS textbooks on Christianity and Islam – topic = Beliefs and teachings

Chapter 4 - of both RS textbooks on Christianity and Islam – topic = Religion and life

Chapter 6 - of both RS textbooks on Christianity and Islam – topic = Religion, peace and conflict

Students are also recommended to purchase the following two textbooks and a revision guide:

Subject: Music

Content and length of exam: Music Theory: 1 hour 30 minutes written paper (no audio required).

List of topics to revise: Note values, time signatures, Staff notation, Construction of chords, frequently used terms and signs.

Revision material can be found online via ABRSM, BBC Bitesize, mymusictheory and education quizzes. Students are recommended to purchase the following reference book: The AB Guide to Music Theory Part 1 – ABRSM - Eric Taylor (ISBN: 9781854724465)

Subject: Art

Content and length of exam: 2 x 50 minute sessions - Sketchbook work to be done.

List of topics to revise: students will use the art exam time to develop their personally informed final response piece (Assessment Objective 4 - AQA Art & Design GCSE). This takes the form of a piece of artwork that represents a culmination of the students' body of research into the materials techniques and processes used by a range of contemporary artists. This piece of work forms 25% of their final grade.

Subject: Prince's Trust

Content and length of exam: no exam will take place for this subject

List of topics to revise: students will be allowed to leave school early for private study at home
