Subject: English

Content and length of exam: 45 minutes

Students will be asked to write a piece of creative writing. In order to build a successful response students should aim to:

- Organise their writing clearly into paragraphs
- Vary their sentence structures
- Use sophisticated vocabulary
- Include varied punctuation
- Use a range of language devices to build imagery
- Develop original and engaging ideas

Subject: MFL

Content and length of exam: 45 minutes

Spanish

Content:

- Saying how you are with the verb *estar* + adjectives.
- Numbers 1-31
- Months of the year + days of the week. Saying when your birthday is with the structure – *mi cumpleaños es el....*
- Colours, animals and combining these with word order
- Family members - and character adjectives to describe them.
- Basic physical description - *Mi padre tiene los ojos verdes y el pelo rubio* etc.

French

Content :

- Saying how you are with the verb *être* + adjectives.
- Numbers 1-31
- Saying where you live using the verb *habiter*...
- Months of the year + days of the week. Saying when your birthday is with the structure – *Mon anniversaire c'est le....*
- Colours, animals and combining these with word order
- Family members - and character adjectives to describe them.
- Animals

Content and length of exam: 50 minutes

Students will complete a baseline assessment to establish their knowledge-base from KS2 (Primary School) – they will not need to revise to do this.

Subject: Art

Content and length of exam: 50 minutes

Students will be asked to carry out a technical drawing task. They will be assessed on their use of line, tone and form.

Subject: Geography

Content and length of exam:

Students will be completing work around the key question: *Why are Europe's borders where they are?*

They will be asked to:

- Identify countries within the European Union
- Compare the map of Europe in the past with some now

- Identify which countries have gained independence and how their borders have changed

Subject: Spanish

Content and length of exam: Holidays. Two exams = 1 hour 30 minutes (1 x reading = 30 minutes & 1 x writing = 1 hour). Listening will take place prior during normal lessons.

List of topics to revise: holiday destinations & preferences, what you usually/can do on holiday, holidays in the past/disastrous holidays, telling a story using sequencing words, using prepositions for countries and modes of transport, revision of estar + past participle, revision of the imperfect and preterite tenses, describing a region in Spanish, and talking about the weather.

Subject: French

Content and length of exam: Holidays. Two exams = 1 hour 30 minutes (1 x reading = 30 minutes & 1 x writing = 1 hour). Listening will take place prior during normal lessons.

List of topics to revise: holiday destinations & preferences, what you usually/can do on holiday, holidays in the past/disastrous holidays, telling a story using sequencing words, using prepositions for countries and modes of transport, revision of the perfect tense of avoir, revision of the imperfect tense of avoir, être and faire, describing a region in France, and talking about the weather.
