School aims

With reference to the School's **Vulnerable Students Improvement Plan**, our main strategic aim is:

Raising standards, opportunities and the academic progress for our vulnerable students.

Provision in place

Southborough High School has a number of new interventions put in place to support those students that are eligible to benefit from the PPG during 2017/18. PPG students will have benefited from one or more of the interventions funded or part funded through the PPG:

- Smaller class sizes and mixed ability grouping in ALL lessons in KS3 and KS4 to focus on intensive support and feedback to all PPG students
- Employment of two Learning Facilitators to focus only on PPG students' progress
- 'Engage' mentoring programme to support disengaged PPG students
- Free breakfast and/or lunch through the ACE mentoring programme

Measuring the impact of PPG funding in 2016-17

Year 7 – In English, 96% of PPG made at least the expected levels of progress. In Maths it was 63%.

Year 8 – In English, 93% of PPG made at least the expected levels of progress. In maths it was 50%.

Year 9 – in English, 81% of PPG made at least the expected levels of progress. In maths it was 56%.

Year 10 – In English, 88% of PPG made at least the expected levels of progress. In maths it was 64%.

Year 11 –The progress score for Year 11 students was +0.02
