This is an Applied General qualification and is designed primarily to support learners progressing to university.

It has been designed to offer exciting and interesting experiences that focus learning for 16-19 year-old learners through applied learning, i.e. through the acquisition of knowledge and understanding in purposeful contexts linked to the criminal justice system.

It is made up of 4 units and comprises of 50% internally assessed coursework and 50% externally assessed examinations.


Each unit has an applied purpose which acts as a focus for the learning in the unit
