Students will need to respond to a fiction text in section A and write a non-fiction text in section B. Section A will involve looking at writer's use of language, structure and other methods to present meaning. In Section B, they must produce a text presenting a view or perspective.
English 2	1hr 30min	English Language Paper 2 (Non-fiction texts) Writers' perspectives and viewpoints. Students will need to respond to 2 non-fiction sources in section A and write a non-fiction text in section B. Section A will involve looking at writer's views and perspectives and how they use language and other methods to present these. Students will also be asked to compare the two sources in terms of their views and perspectives. In Section B, they must produce a text presenting a view or perspective.
